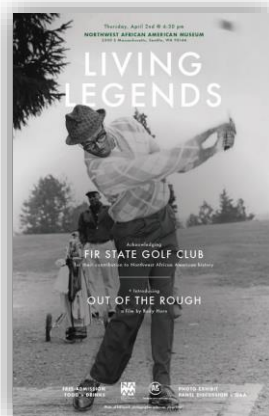

Fir State History and Mission

Fir State was established in 1945 to provide a means for minorities to learn and compete in the sport of golf. In 1954 Fir State became one of the found clubs of the Western States Golf Association (WSGA), which not boasts 32 member clubs in seven states. WSGA is nationally recognized for its junior golf programs and tournaments, as well as its collaboration with the National Minority Junior Golf Program.

As the older club in the WSGA, Fir State enjoys a rich history of accomplishments, dating back to 1955 when Bill Wright Jr., one of the clubs first junior golfers, placed second in the Seattle High School Championship. In 1959, he went on to capture the prestigious National Public Links Championship, becoming the first black golfer to achieve that distinction. In 1994, a tradition was continued when high school freshman and Fir State junior golfer Tyson LaNore won the same championship and a spot in the national Maxfli Junior Championships.

Among our exciting activities were the annual Celebrity Tournament, inaugurated in 1992 by host Tiger Woods and since hosted by Ken Griffey, Sr., Warren Moon, Dale Ellis, and Nate McMillan. Fund raised benefitted the Fir State Junior Golf Foundation, and supported our junior golf scholarship programs.

Founded primarily as an African American golf organization, Fir State is committed to promoting equal opportunities, equal access, and full participation to diverse groups regardless of race, color, gender, age, or economic status.

Fir State is committed to conducting organized golf tournaments, club outings, and golf events with an emphasis on spirited competition, skill enhancement, and camaraderie.

Fir State is dedicated to promoting and building citizenship, fellowship, high ethical standards, self esteem and self-discipline, while upholding the standards and integrity of the game of golf.

Fir State is committed to encouraging respect, pride, and a greater sense of community through the game of golf, with a particular emphasis on preserving the legacy of the club and junior golf program.

Through the Fir State Junior Golf Foundation and scholarship program, the club is committed to actively investing in our community's youth by providing leadership, mentoring, tutoring and scholarships based on scholastic aptitude and golf proficiency.
