General Information

Fir State Golf Club (FSGC) is pleased to announce FSGC Scholarship, offering scholarship opportunities for academically deserving seniors, with financial needs attending a high school in the greater Seattle area with accumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. The scholarship will be awarded to a qualified student in the amount ranging from \$2,500 up to \$5,000. This Scholarships is intended for undergraduate college attendance, beginning in the fall of the current calendar year, at an accredited college or university. All scholarship awards will be paid directly to the institution or recipient.

Eligibility

High school seniors may apply for the scholarship:

Previous recipients that are current full-time college students:

Academic - Eligible students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale

Applicant must reside and is a graduate of a high school in greater Seattle.

The recipient must attend an accredited college or university in the U.S. and remain in good standing during the year for which the scholarship is awarded.

 - Personal Response to Two (2) statements listed in Section 3
 - Counselor recommendation in Section 4, also, include an official copy of the candidate high school transcript
 - Two (2) Recommendations letters highlighting the points outlined in Section 5
 - i. Letter of recommendation from High School Staff Member
 - ii. Letter of recommendation from Community Project Coordinator
2. A copy of the candidate's acceptance letter from the accredited institution they plan to attend

Application Deadline

A complete application package must be submitted and postmarked no later than **May 31, of the current calendar year** or the application will be ineligible for consideration.

Notification

All applying candidates will be notified via email of FSGC scholarship recipient winner **on or before the 3rd week in June of the current calendar year.**
